Web 308 Client	The Web 308 Client is now included in the RightFax 10 ISO. To install it, you run a separate installer. The Web 308 Client is used for accessibility.	n/a
WebUtil	WebUtil is now included with the RightFax Server licensing. Previously, use of WebUtil required the purchase of a separate license.	n/a

Feature	Description	More Information
Clustering	Because RightFax 10 does not support Windows Server 2003, clustering is currently not supported in RightFax 10.0.	n/a
Docs	The\RightFax\Docs\ folder has been removed. Documentation is available online only. If you upgrade RightFax, the Docs folder remains in place, but you can choose to remove it, if you wish.	RightFax Online Documentation
EDC	OpenText has discontinued the Sharp and Canon EDC modules. Existing customers can use the multifunction product SMTP Connector for no additional charge. To ensure that your licensing is correct, before you upgrade, complete an upgrade request form and specify that you use these connectors.	Partners, see Product Bulletin 1052.
Enterprise Fax Manager (EFM) SQL Server Free Space Statistic	EFM no longer shows the free disk space available to SQL Server. You can still enable notifications for SQL Server free disk space.	n/a
Microsoft Exchange Server 2003	Exchange 2003 is no longer supported. RightFax 10 supports Exchange 2007 and 2010.	n/a
GroupWise	Novell GroupWise gateway is no longer supported. Use the RightFax SMTP Gateway instead.	RightFax 10 Administrators Guide
Help	The question mark "?" at the top right of most windows in Enterprise Fax Manager has been removed because Windows Server 2008 does not support .hlp files.	n/a
RightFax 9.3 Upgrade	RightFax 9.3 cannot be upgraded to RightFax 10. You must upgrade from RightFax 9.4.	n/a
SQL Server 2000	SQL Server 2000 is no longer supported.	n/a
TR114 Boards	TR114 fax boards are not supported in RightFax 10 because Dialogic does not provide drivers that are compatible with Windows Server 2008. (RightFax 10 RTM allows you to add a TR114 board to DocTransport, but the board does not work.)	RightFax 10 Fax Board Guide
Windows Server 2003	Windows Server 2003 (including R2) is no longer supported.	n/a
